Watch live starts on the RYS line

1000 Extreme 40s - first start White Group line (inshore RYS line, Sat-Thu only)

1025 SB3s - second start White Group Sat-Thu, first start Fri-Sat

Subsequent starts on White Group line at 10 minute intervals, alternating with Black Group starts

1030 First start on Black Group line (offshore RYS line) except Tuesday when 0930 start for Artemis Challenge

Subsequent starts on Black Group line at 10 minute intervals - final start 1220, 1230, or 1240 depending on day

1245 Victory start - final start on White Group line if XODs are NOT starting on the RYS line

1255 XOD start - final start on White Group line if XODs are starting on the RYS line

1400 onwards - live finishing action on the Squadron line depending on courses set for the day and conditions

Daily:

- 0830 - 1200 Watch yachts leaving the harbour for their starts
- 1100 - 1500 Lots of harbour traffic as yachts and commercial traffic come and go - it gets busy!
- 1400 - 1800 Yachts returning from racing fill the harbour and entrance channel - lots to see!
- 1800 - 2100 Evening traffic and sunset over the harbour
